Clue 4

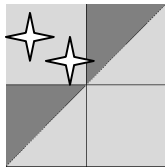
Pieced border:

1. Sew a 2-7/8" triangle of Fabric 3 (Dark) to a 2-7/8" triangle of Fabric 2 (Background). Fold back (carefully—it's bias!) and press to form a square. Square up to 2-1/2."

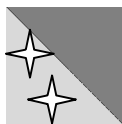


You'll need 28 for Double, 36 for Queen.

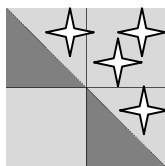
2. Arrange these pieced squares with a 2-1/2" Background square and a 2-1/2" Print square to form 4-patches. Square up to 4-1/2." (You will have 14 for Double, 18 for Queen.)



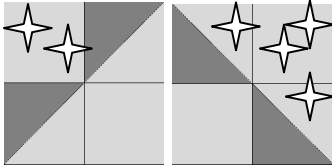
3. Sew a 2-7/8" triangle of Fabric 3 (Dark) to a 2-7/8" triangle of Fabric 1 (Print). Fold back (carefully—it's bias!) and press to form a square. Square up to 2-1/2." Make 28 for Double, 36 for Queen.



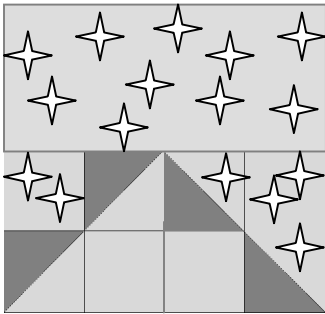
4. Arrange these pieced squares with a 2-1/2" Print square and a 2-1/2" Background square to form 4-patches. Square up to 4-1/2." You'll have 14 for Double, 18 for Queen.



5. Sew these 2 units together:



6. After construction the units, sew $4\frac{1}{2}$ " x $8\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangle of print fabric and sew to the top of the unit.



For the double quilt you will need: 14
For the queen quilt you will need: 18
